



Student Case Study Competition 21.9.2017-22.9.2017

PROTOCOL OF THE COMPETITION

1. Teams of secondary school students consist of 3 members (14 to 19 years of age). Each participating school can have no more than two teams in the competition.
2. The presentation of the problem is on the first day (21.9.2017). All of the students as well as the jury member are attending. Jury member presenting the Case study has to be available via email for questions until the presentations.
3. The presentation of the problem will be sent to all the group leaders via email.
4. At the end of the presentation, the participants are presented the rules of the competition and the draw for the order of solution presentations takes place.
5. Teams are preparing their solutions and presentations the second day (22.9.2017).
6. All teams have to submit their presentations to the person responsible for the presentations before the start (22.9.2017 before 10:00). Any late submissions result in the automatic disqualification.
7. The jury consists of 3-4 members one of which is the presenter of the Case study.
8. Presentations take place in the order of the draw. The length of the solution presentations is 15 minutes. If the event of exceeding the time limit the presentation is interrupted. After the presentation each jury member and members of other participating teams can ask additional questions.
9. Solution presentations are public. Each team has the right to join other attendants, but only after finishing their presentation.
10. The announcement of the winner follows on the same day.

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
