- Why?** You work with students from all partner countries on a common
project.
- If you are selected, you are entitled to a grant of 250€ (upon final
approval of DAAD). The **participation** at the summer school
is **free** as well as some of the activities and the food during the
day. On Tuesday, we invite all our guests to a welcome dinner.

Learning Outcomes After this Summer School you will be able to:

- **Assess** which tools/methods are adequate for your teaching
- **Decide** how digital tools (like Videos, online-surveys, Podcasts, etc.)/methods can enrich your teaching
- **Use** digital media in a sensitive and appropriate way
- **Reflect** on the use of digital media in class
- **Design** lessons including digital media

The Summer School's main aim is to discuss and reflect future teacher education while also focusing on the major topic of digitalisation in education. Participants will be working on different questions regarding the use of digital tools within teacher education.
