


THE SWEDISH EDUCATION SYSTEM

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CONTEMPORARY EDUCATION - SOME NUMBERS

More than 3 million individuals in school/education on a daily basis in Sweden.

- School children: 522 000 in preschool (2019), 123 000 in preschool class (2020/21), 10 000 in other type of childcare (2020), 1 100 000 in compulsory school (2020/21).
- Students: 360 000 in upper secondary school (2020/21), 215 000 in Folk high school (2021), 400 000 in adult education (2020), 450 000 registered in higher education (2021), 17 000 in postgraduate training (2020).
- Teachers: 156 000 (2019)

THE SWEDISH EDUCATION SYSTEM - A SUM-UP

- All children have access to 'free' education.
- Ten years of schooling is mandatory (incl. "preschool year").
- Upper secondary school (gymnasiet) is optional but most young people choose to enroll.
- Education is regulated at the national level, but the municipalities decide about resource allocation and organisation.
- A large number of independent schools with public funding (charter schools).
