## WEBSITE

- Citation according to the model for online publications is used exclusively when the work cannot be categorised in the above examples and when the source used has no publication to which it is linked (e.g. to a journal, a newspaper, a blog, a conference report).
- Since they often have no author, we adapt the reference format to the given data. We try to find the author based on the sections on the website. If the author and the name of the website are identical, we omit the name of the website and do not cite it twice. The titles of the articles are written in italics. We do not indicate the date on which we obtained the references from the Internet. If a web link disappears from the Internet, the date given would be of no use to us in locating the source used.

### Website without author and publication date

We used some text from the website. The text has no author (or organization) and no date. We only have the title of the paper.
